In this Sunday's reading from the Gospel of Mark, Jesus was teaching his disciples. The disciples were arguing about which one of them was the greatest so Jesus called them together and said, "If anyone wants to be first, he must make himself last of all and servant of all." Jesus then put his arms around a little child and said to them, "Anyone who welcomes one of these little children in my name welcomes me; and anyone who welcomes me welcomes not me but the one who sent me."

These are such important words from Jesus and a lesson that we can share with our children. In eighth grade religion we discussed this Gospel reading and the importance of putting others first and being welcoming to all. In our world this is sometimes a hard thing to do, but that's the challenge we take up when we follow Jesus. Today we are called to place the needs of others before our own. Each of our children can understand this message if we put it into their language. Together, as partners in their spiritual growth, let's help them begin to understand how good it feels to help others and follow Jesus' advice.
