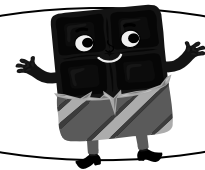
## News from the office:

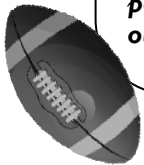
### Sports News at MHT
