Dear Families and friends of Most Holy Trinity School,

Last Sunday we listened to the Gospel story of the Transfiguration, where Jesus changes in appearance before the eyes of his apostles. I came upon this description of Transfiguration: "Transfiguration is an event that translates worldly reality into heavenly reality without ever leaving the ground. It lifts the cloak of sin from the world so that we can glimpse, for an instant, what the truth is. The truth about Jesus is that he is God's Son. The truth about us is that we're glory bound."

I share this with you as together we begin our second week of Lent.
